

Children get their primary school offer

More than 98 per cent of children in Medway who will be starting primary school in September have been offered a place at one of their preferred schools.

Families will start finding out which primary or infant school their child has been offered for September 2019 today, Tuesday, 16 April.

Every Medway child who applied on time has secured a place and 3,413 Medway children have been offered places.

The school admissions process for Medway is a huge task and involves the council processing primary school applications for 3,525 children, including 112 children from outside the Medway area.

More than 98.5 per cent of families used the council's online application process to submit their preferences this year.
